COACH NOTEBOOK

- Jason is the second-winningest coach in Bobcat history with 52 wins, trailing only Jack Luettker (157 wins in 29 seasons)
- His .800 winning percentage is tied with Ed Osnowitz (40-9-1, .800 from 1961-1965) for first place on Whiteford coaching lists
- Jason is No. 10 on the all-time list of Tri-County Conference overall coaching victories (52) and second in winning percentage (.800). He's 10th in TCC wins as well (30) and second in win percentage (.857)
- Has a playoff record of 10-5, tied for second-most playoff wins of any TCC-coach
- Whiteford's current string of five consecutive playoff appearances is a school record (the TCC record is seven)

POST-GAME NOTES

- When Thomas Eitniear threw a touchdown pass in the first quarter against Whitmore Lake to his brother, Ty Eitniear, the duo became just the third brother combination in Whiteford history to team up on a touchdown pass (Doug Herman to Red Herman, 1968; Joe Gust to Jake Gust, 2002).
- Thomas Eitniear now has 28 career touchdown passes, tying him with Gabe LaRoy for the career lead in Whiteford touchdown passes.
- The 86 points combined is tied for the third-highest point total in Whiteford history (The record is 100).
- Whitmore Lake punted once for 29 yards. The Bobcats have yet to return a punt this season.
